- If you could define CCCC in one word, what would it be? Why?
- How do you define missional?
- Read Mt. 28:19-20.
  - o What stands out to you about this passage?
  - o Why is this known as the Great Commission?
  - o How has CCCC summarized this mission?

## "Our mission is to lead unchurched people into becoming fully devoted followers of Jesus."

- o What stands out to you about CCCC's statement?
- Why is there an emphasis on "unchurched people"? Who do they represent?
- Many think of the Houston Bay Area as a very churched place but statistically speaking that isn't true. How have you seen this area become more secular?

## Read Luke 15:1-2

- What category of people were "tax collectors" and "sinners" classified as in Jesus' day?
- o What is the problem the religious leaders had with Jesus? Why?
- What does this tell us about how Jesus went about ministering to others and sharing the gospel?
- o What did they accuse Jesus of in Luke 7:34?
- What can this tell us about living missionally and being misunderstood for it by religious people?
- o How can we abuse the idea of being a "friend to sinners"?

## • Read Luke, 5:30-32.

- What is Jesus' motivation for connecting with unchurched people?
- Yancey mentioned a simple three-step process for how we can live local and connect with the broader community for mission, what were those steps?

STEP 1: befriend our unchurched neighbors, friends, and workmates

STEP 2: share with them a verbal witness about Jesus

STEP 3: invite them to a service (or a group)
