### Read James 3:13-14.

- Based on these opening verses, what is the main point that James is going to make in this passage?
- He's setting up a comparison between two kinds of wisdom. We might call them True Wisdom and False Wisdom. How does he describe these two kinds of wisdom?
- O What is wisdom?

## • Read James 3:15.

- What is the source of each kind of wisdom?
- o Where do people look to get wisdom today?
- O Where do you turn to get wisdom?

### Read James 3:16-18.

- What are the outcomes of each kind of wisdom?
- How have you seen the negative outcomes of False Wisdom in your life?
- If you're honest with yourself, does your life right now more resemble the outcomes of False Wisdom or True Wisdom?
- When you read the list of outcomes of True Wisdom, are you encouraged or discouraged? Why?

### Read 1 Corinthians 1:30.

- o How is Jesus "wisdom from God"?
- o How does faith in Jesus connect to a life of wisdom?

### Application & Reflection

- Which of the gospel identities (citizen, family, missionary) does this message most intersect?
- How does this passage challenge you?
- o What will do you in response? How can your group help?
