Discussion Questions

- 1. What are you afraid of? How do you respond when that thing scares you?
- 2. Who do you know who has the most extreme response to a fear? What do they do?
- 3. Read Nehemiah 5:1-9; 14-16 and answer the following questions:
  - a. What is going on among the people of Israel?
  - b. What does Nehemiah do differently than the "nobles and officials"?
  - c. Why is the "fear of God" the source of the difference in their behavior?
- 4. How is Nehemiah's behavior an "extreme reaction" to the fear of God? What makes it extreme?
- 5. What would it look like for someone in our context to have an extreme reaction to the fear of God the way Nehemiah does? What would they do?
- 6. Read Deuteronomy 10:12. Based on this text how would you define the "fear of God"? What does it involve? What is the difference between "fearing God" and being afraid of God?
- 7. Discuss how Jesus feared God more than any man who ever lived. How does his gospel represent the true "fear of God" in a person's life?
- 8. Read 1 John 4:18-21. How does John explain the relationship between fear and love? How does the fear of God evidence itself in a person's life?
- 9. Why is it so important that the nobles and officials of Israel "fear God"? What is the impact of their lack of fear?
- 10. Discuss how the "fear of God" is the critical element for being a true People of Hope? Pray for the group, for CCCC to live out the "fear of God."
