- Read Matthew 11:19 and 1 Corinthians 6:9-11. How do these passages describe the people that Jesus came to disciple? How do these passages give you hope in your own walk of faith and in how you disciple others?
- What do the letters in the acronym B.L.E.S.S. stand for? How does this acronym encourage us to explore faith and make disciples?

- Read Hebrews 10:24-25. What are both the positive and negative commands in this passage? In what ways are you currently stirring up one another to love and good works?
- What is the third movement of CCCC’s strategy?
- Read Ephesians 4:11-12. How has God gifted you for the work of ministry?
- Why does CCCC seek to have 10 campuses in the 4B Area? (Also, review the boundaries of the 4B Area.)
- What are the 4 commitments/relationships of membership at CCCC?
