#### **Discussion Questions**

- **Ice Breaker:**
  - When have you recently served someone that you didn't know?
  - Did you struggle with any selfish desires when doing so?
- **Read 1 Peter 4:7-11.**
  - What does Peter say we should do in light of the “end of all things”?
  - What is significant about the ordinariness of what he says?
  - How many times do you see the phrase “one another”? How are these related?
  - What do you think “love covers a multitude of sins” means?
  - Why does Peter say to show hospitality *without grumbling*? Do you struggle with this?
  - What categories of spiritual gifts does Peter list?
- **Read Romans 12:6-8; 1 Corinthians 12:8-10, 28.**
  - What spiritual gifts do you think you might have?
  - Are you currently using your gifts in some way? If so, how?
- **1 Peter 4:11**
  - Why does Peter end by praising God?
  - What do spiritual gifts have to do with worship?
- **Application & Reflection**
  - Which of the gospel identities (citizen, family, missionary) does this message most intersect?
  - If you currently serve somewhere in the church, talk about your experience.
  - If you don't currently serve, how does this passage challenge you?
  - What will you do in response? How can your group help?
