How does the gospel give us a <u>path</u> to experience a healthy and beautiful marriage?

- Why is addressing and repenting of your own sin the first step down the path of a good marriage?
- o What does it look like to "die to yourself" in marriage?

- What makes your spouse feel joy? What can you do to bring them joy this week?
- What attitudes or behaviors of yours are unloving to your spouse?
 What do you need God to change about you?
- o How can you love and respect your spouse this week?

• If you aren't married...

- How does this message impact your view of marriage?
- If you are looking to be married one day, how does this change what you're looking for in a future spouse?
- Which of the gospel identities (citizen, family, missionary) does this message most intersect?
