- Reflect on this statement from The Jesus Storybook Bible The Bible isn't a book of rules, or a book of heroes. The Bible is most of all a story.
 - How would you answer, "What is the story of the Bible?"
- Read Genesis 1:27
 - What does it mean that humans are made in the image of God?
 - What does it mean that humans, male & female, are made in the image of God?
- Read Genesis 3:1-7
 - What irony do you see in this part of the story?
 - What is the lie that the man and woman believed?
- Read John 1:1-4, 14
 - What parallels do you see between the creation story and this passage?
 - What is the significance of Jesus "dwelling among us?"
- Read Revelation 21:1-4
 - What story is God telling about the new heavens and new earth?
- Consider the storyline: CREATION >> FALL >> REDEMPTION >> NEW CREATION
 - How is this Biblical storyline greater than anything else competing for our attention and affection?
- How does worship re-story us to this gospel storyline?
 - How have you personally seen singing, prayer, Lord's Supper, giving, or baptism remind you of the story God is telling in the world?
- Considering the Spiritual Growth Grid and the overarching call to Repent and Believe in the Gospel, what lesser stories do you need to repent of to re-story yourself and believe in the gospel?
