Discussion Questions

- Read Colossians 1:15-20. How does this text reveal Jesus as part of the Trinity? What does Jesus going to the cross teach us about the nature of the Trinity?
- Read John 8:42; John 14:26; John 15:26. How do each of these texts describe the roles of members of the Trinity? What other texts can you think of that describe the members of the Trinity submitting to the others?
- How is each member of the Trinity involved in our salvation?
- Share some experiences where other people keep you from “doing what you want to do.” What are some situations where you feel like God is keeping you from doing what you want to do?
- Read Ephesians 3:14-4:7. Summarize this whole text. What does Paul pray God will do in us?
- How can we be “filled with the fullness of God”? We are not part of the Trinity, so what does Paul mean?
- How does the love of God in Trinity help us understand who we are and how we relate to one another as his family?
- Speak some names of people who serve God and us at CCCC. Pray that God will give them joy and satisfaction in their serving. As a group come up with a way you will tell them you are grateful for how they love us.
