Discussion Questions

- **What have been the key takeaways from Revelation for you?**
  - As we began this series, what came to your mind when you thought about Revelation?
  - How did the last 12 weeks change that?
- **Read Revelation 22:6-7**
  - How is this passage similar to Revelation 1:3?
  - What does it mean and why is it important to “keep” Revelation?
  - How does Jesus mean when he says he is coming “soon”?
- **Read Revelation 22:8-11**
  - Why did John include a second instance of him being corrected to worship God alone? What does this teach us about idolatry?
  - How are you tempted to worship someone or something other than God?
  - What does mean verse 11 mean? How does it call you to live?
- **Read Revelation 22:12-16**
  - What stands out to you about this passage?
  - How are Christians saved? What role do good works play?
  - What are the blessings of salvation?
- **Read Revelation 22:17**
  - What stands out to you about this passage?
  - Who is invited to “come” in this passage?
- **Read Revelation 22:18-19**
  - What does the warning about adding to or taking away from the words of the prophecy of the book mean? (see also Deuteronomy 4:1-8)
- **Which of the gospel identities (citizen, family, missionary) does Revelation 22:6-21 highlight? How can we encourage each other to endure in our faith in Jesus (i.e. Do Revelation!)?**
- **Close your discussion by reading Revelation 22:20-21 and praying for Jesus’ return to make ALL THINGS NEW.**
