In the sermon the speaker said that "Misconception about the Trinity will lead you to misconceptions about the Gospel". Why is that? and can you think of some examples where you've seen that to be true?

READ EPHESIANS 1:3-6 - The Father Planned

- What did The Father's plan entail? And when did this plan come to be?
- Why is it important that the Gospel story is rooted out of time and not in time?
- What does this teach us about who God the Father is and what involvement He had within the Gospel Story?
- According to this text was the primary emotion that motivated God to redeem a people to Himself?

READ EPHESIANS 1:7-12 - The Son Purchased

- What does this text teach us about the role of the Son and His involvement within the Gospel story?
- According to this text, how is it that the Son is able to purchase us back to God?
- Why is it important that we see the unity between the Plan of the Father and the Obedience of the Son to carry out that plan?
- The speaker said that at the Cross the eternal love that the father and son is made available to us. ?

READ EPHESIANS 1:13-14 - The Spirit Preserved

- What does this text teach us about the role of the Spirit and His involvement within the Gospel Story?
- The speaker said that in this third Gospel movement the gospel goes from being just a story to becoming our story". According to this text how does this happen?
- What does it mean to be "sealed with the promised Holy Spirit"?
- Why should the Spirit's role in Salvation give you confidence as you live the Christian life?

How does the Trinity better help you understand the innerworkings of the Gospel? What should the natural response be to hearing how the Father, Son, and Spirit have all been at work in this miraculous plan of love?
