- Read John 15:1-8.
 - o In v. 1, knowing that the vine often represented Old Testament Israel, what is Jesus now saying about himself?
 - o How is Jesus the better "people of God" compared to ancient Israel?
- Read John 15:2-3 again.
 - o In the rest of John 15 how are fruit defined?
 - o What does this say about spiritual fruitlessness?
 - Why would Jesus make such a confident statement about salvation and its effect on us?
- Read John 15:4-8 once again.
 - o What does it look like to abide in Jesus?
 - Why is this "abiding" not only a mark of salvation but how salvation works its way out in the life of someone's life?
 - o How can we best abide in Jesus?
 - Personally?
 - Corporally?
- What stands out to you most about Jesus' words about himself being the True Vine?
 - o How can we best apply these words today?
- Which of the gospel identities (citizen, family, missionary) does this message most intersect? Why?
