Discussion Questions

1. Who would you call with your one phone call from jail?
2. Read Isaiah 33:1-4. What does Judah say to God that indicates their change of heart?
3. What is repentance?
4. Read Isaiah 33:5-6. What stands out to you about how God is described in this passage?
5. Read Isaiah 33:7-9. How is Judah's present situation described?
6. Read Isaiah 33:10-12. What is God's response to Judah's cry of salvation to him as their last resort?
7. Read Isaiah 33:13-14. Why does "the sinners of Zion" (i.e. God's people) ask these two questions in verse 14?
8. Read Isaiah 33:15-16. How do we know that God isn't saying we are saved by our good works?
9. What is the connection between faith and works?
10. Read Isaiah 33:17-22. What is most encouraging to you about this description of eternity?
11. Read Isaiah 33:23-24. Why is it significant that God's people are pictured as a distressed sailboat?
12. What area of your life is in need of repentance?
13. What does Isaiah 33 teach us about God's response to a repentant sinner?
