- Using the analogy of a doctor, why is it important to be honest about the truth, even when there is bad news?
- Read Revelation 20:11-15. What does this passage describe? What are the two books and what do they record?
- Read Matthew 25:30, 41, 46. Who is speaking in this passage? What does the speaker describe in this passage? Why is it significant who the speaker is?
- What are some reasons people struggle with the concept of hell? In what ways do you struggle with the concept of hell?
- Most everyone has wrestled with the question: “How could a loving God send people to hell?” According to Romans 1:22-24, who is it that makes the decision to go to hell?
- Why is it important that God judges righteously? How does judgement bring justice?
- Read Revelation 13:8. Who is the “Lamb who was slain?” What has this Lamb done for us in order to provide a way for our names to be written in the “Lamb’s book of life?”
- How then should we respond in order for our names to be written in the “Lamb’s book of life?” (See John 3:16, Acts 16:31, Romans 10:9, Colossians 1:13-14).
- Would anyone in the group like to share about the moment that they responded to Jesus?
- Close small group by praying together and asking him to help us to respond to Jesus.
