 - How did the church respond to Peter's release from prison?
 - What scenarios come to mind where you tend to think, there is NO WAY _____?
 - Where have you seen God answer your prayers and what was your reaction?

- **Read Acts 12:18-23.**
 - Summarize what is going on in this passage?
 - What causes Herod to lose his life?

- **Read Acts 12:24**
 - How does this passage strengthen your faith?
 - What ways have you seen the movement of God increase and multiply (in your life and in others) even in the midst of trials, hardships and persecution?
