 - What stands out to you about these passages?

 - What are stories you can share about that influence?
 - Is there anything you do that is because of your mother (or father)?
 - What does this tell us about the influence of a parent?
- How can parents become influencers for the gospel in their home?
 - What does that look like?
 - Does that change as your children get older? How?
 - How can we point our kids to the gospel even when we blow it as a parent?
- How can moms (or any parent) to fall into the idolatry of motherhood? What would make your role as a parent an idolatrous one?
- How does the gospel re-center us and fight against the idolatry of parenting?
 - How can small group be an effective weapon in that fight?
 - How can our gospel identities of either citizens, family, or missionaries aid in our discipleship as parents who point our children to Jesus?
