**START**

It can be easy to come and worship God when everything is going great in our lives. It can be difficult to worship God when our lives seem to be unraveling. The truth is we worship from the depths of our soul. Which means we can worship in our highs and lows.

**READ**

[Genesis 22:12](#) (NIV)

“Do not lay a hand on the boy,” he said. “Do not do anything to him. Now I know that you fear God, because you have not withheld from me your son, your only son.”

**THINK**

Take a moment to imagine what was going through Abraham's mind when God asked him to sacrifice his only son. The very son God provided for him to start the making of a nation. Many times Abraham took matters into his own hands, but not this time. This trusted God and obeyed Him no matter what the cost would be.

- Has God ever called you to do something that would significantly cost you?
- What are some things following Jesus has cost you?
- What did God provide for you out of your obedience?

When we obey God no matter the cost we put every ounce of trust in who God says He is. We realize that God writes a better story for our life than we could ever imagine writing. It can be hard and faith challenging, but obey God no matter what leads to a life that is better than we could ever imagine because it is aligned with God's purpose for our life.

**PRAY**
