START

READ

[Genesis 15:5-6](#) (NIV)

He took him outside and said, “Look up at the sky and count the stars—if indeed you can count them.” Then he said to him, “So shall your offspring be.” Abram believed the Lord, and he credited it to him as righteousness.

THINK

Following God can be difficult when we have so much uncertainty towards our own abilities. Maybe we think we are not good enough, smart enough, charismatic enough, loving enough. The list of uncertainties in our life are numerous. Despite our uncertainties, God promises to protect us and provide for us.

- What uncertainties do you have in your ability to follow God?
- Why do we find it difficult to trust God to protect and provide for us?
- How has God protected you and provided for you?

When life is hard and the world is falling apart around us, we so often look down in despair. God lifts our eyes to look up towards Him. In the moments of despair and uncertainty take comfort and courage and look up to God for His guidance.

- What has you looking down at this moment in your life?
- How can we help you look up?
- Will you overlook your uncertainty?

PRAY

“God, life is filled with uncertainties. There are uncertainties in my own capabilities as I follow you. Help me to look up towards you and continue to protect me and provide for me. You alone know what is best for my life and for the lives of those I love.”

ACT

This week when you are overwhelmed with uncertainty, look up and remember that God promises to protect and provide. Write these promises down somewhere to remind you that God is for us.
