START

READ

[Luke 15:24](#) (NLT)

"for this son of mine was dead and has now returned to life. He was lost, but now he is found."

THINK

In the story of the prodigal son, one brother squanders everything the father gives him, yet the father still accepts him back when he repents and returns home. The other son is upset that he stays and does what is right and is mad that the younger son is accepted.

- Which son do you relate to the most?
- How have you reacted as the first son in your life?
- How have you reacted as the second son?

Casey said, "the position of your heart will determine who you relate to the most." Often what comes out in our language and actions is a result of what is in our hearts. Jesus desires to transform our hearts to better mirror Him.

- How are you taking time to reflect on what's in your heart?
- What area of your heart do you need to allow Jesus to work on?
- How can you intentionally hangout and accept others who are far from God?

PRAY

Pray that God reveals what's in your heart and continues to shape your heart to be more like Him.

ACT

This week, determine which son you relate to most. If there is something you need to repent of and return to God, take the step to do so. If you need to forgive someone and welcome them back to God's kingdom, take the step to do that.
