BIG IDEA:

The will of God is not so mysterious as to not be understood. God, in fact has made His will clear, and desires us to understand it, which begins with yielding to what He has revealed.

Divine Will (decreed will): This includes all that God has ordained to occur, including what He allows. It comprises His revealed will (what we can know) and His hidden will (that which He has chosen not to reveal)

Moral Will:

**This is God's
prescription of what His
creatures should do or
abstain from doing; it
includes God's desire for
righteousness and His
repudiation of evil**





Special/Particular

Will: This is God's will for us individually or in a particular situation; it is the aspect of God's will that typically comes to mind when we ask, "God what will you have me do?"
