ACTS 16:1-8

1 Now Paul also came to Derbe and to Lystra. And a disciple was there, named Timothy, the son of a Jewish woman who was a believer, but his father was a Greek, 2 and he was well spoken of by the brothers and sisters who were in Lystra and Iconium.

3 Paul wanted this man to leave with him: and he took him and circumcised him
