Prayer

<u>Key Verse:</u> "In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one. For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen." Matthew 6:9-13

<u>Purpose:</u> The purpose of this lesson is to help the disciple develop a consistent, disciplined, and biblical prayer life.

- "TO PRAY":
 - There is a difference between praying and saying prayers.
 - The disciples knew the *ritual* of prayer. They wanted to learn the *art* of effective prayer.

The Model Prayer

In Matthew 6:9-13 and Luke 11:2-4 we have recorded the Lord's model prayer for His disciples. Since Jesus taught against vain repetition, He did not intend that the model prayer be a "verbatim prayer". Instead, according to Burgess and Proudlove, in their book, <u>Watching unto Prayer</u>, the Jewish rabbis were in the habit of teaching the people outline prayers which were known as "index prayers". These index prayers contained a number of short sentences which suggested an item to remember in prayer. The people would recite a sentence and then enlarge upon it in their own prayer, drawing out some of its implications, conclusions, and applications. No doubt the disciples were familiar with this type of prayer teaching. So when Jesus gave them instruction on how to pray, he simply gave them an index, or *model* prayer. Since Jesus is the Supreme authority on prayer, it would seem that special attention should be given to His model for prayer. Therefore let us examine the Model Prayer as an "index" prayer:

Matthew 6:9-13 KJV

Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be Thy name, Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.

And lead us not into temptation, But deliver us from evil: For Thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever. Amen." Luke 11:2-4 KJV

Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be Thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth. Give us day by day our daily bread. And forgive us our sins; For we also forgive everyone that is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil."

So I say to you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.""
- Luke 18:1-8 "Then He spoke a parable to them, that men always ought to pray and not lose heart, saying: • 'There was in a certain city a judge who did not fear God nor regard man. Now there was a widow in that city; and she came to him, saying, "Get justice for me from my adversary." And he would not for a while; but afterward he said within himself, "Though I do not fear God nor regard man, yet because this widow troubles me I will avenge her, lest by her continual coming she weary me."" Then the Lord said, 'Hear what the unjust judge said. And shall God not avenge His own elect who cry out day and night to Him, though He bears long with them? I tell you that He will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless, when the Son of Man comes, will He really find faith on the earth?"

1. OUR FATHER WHICH ART IN HEAVEN (Prayer of Communion)

- a. Thank God for the blood of Jesus through which to call upon Him as Father
- b. Take time to commune with the Father
- c. Thank God for and identify yourself with the family of God

2. <u>HALLOWED BE THY NAME</u> (Prayer of Worship)

- a. Worship God: Not only is He Father but He is GOD
- b. Hallow the redemptive names of God and in faith declare God to be your Source in each of these areas:

YAHWEH-Tsidkenu	The Lord our Righteousness	Propitiation
YAHWEH-M'Kaddesh	The Lord our Sanctifier	Purifier
YAHWEH-Shalom	The Lord our Peace	Peace
YAHWEH-Shammah	The Lord is There	Present One
YAHWEH-Rophe	The Lord your Healer	Physician
YAHWEH-Jireh	The Lord is Provider	Provider
YAHWEH-Nissi	The Lord my Banner	Protector
YAHWEH-Rohi	The Lord my Shepherd	Pastor

- a. Pray for Christ's Lordship to be realized in the earth
- b. Pray that the kingdoms of this world will become the kingdoms of our God and of His Christ (Revelation 11:15)

4. <u>THY WILL BE DONE ON EARTH AS IT IS IN HEAVEN</u> (Prayer of Consecration)

- a. Yourself
- b. Family
- c. Church
- d. City, region, state, nation, world

5. <u>GIVE US THIS DAY OUR DAILY BREAD</u> (Prayer of Petition)

- a. Bread of Provision (Job, stewardship, income)
- b. Bread of Healing and Deliverance (The children's bread: Matthew 15:26)
- c. Bread of Life (Daily revelation of Jesus: John 6:48)

6. <u>FORGIVE US OUR DEBTS</u> (Prayer of Repentance)

- a. Ask God to forgive you of your sins (I John 1:9)
- b. By faith accept His forgiveness of your sin
- c. By faith accept His cleansing from unrighteousness
- d. Ask God to grant you true repentance (2 Timothy 2:25)

7. <u>AS WE FORGIVE OUR DEBTORS</u> (Prayer of Release)

- a. Forgive those who have sinned against you
- b. Release them from your heart unto God, thus eliminating any ongoing debt to you (Matthew 18:21-35)
- c. As an act of release choose now to love them, bless them, do good to them, and pray for them (Matthew 5:44)
- d. Pray for ultimate reconciliation and restoration

8. <u>LEAD US NOT INTO TEMPTATION</u> (Prayer of Preservation)

- a. Acknowledge before God your own natural vulnerability to sin and to the flesh
- b. Ask God, who knows our frame, to guide you away from situations that bring overwhelming temptation
- c. Determine to make no provision for the flesh to fulfill its lusts
- d. Ask God for wisdom in setting godly boundaries for your life

9. <u>DELIVER US FROM THE EVIL ONE</u> (Prayer of Deliverance)

- a. Ask God to deliver you from current demonic assault
- b. Ask God to deliver you from personal strongholds of sin
- c. Ask God to deliver you from this world's system of values

- d. Ask God to deliver you today from the unseen schemes and strategies of the evil one being planned against you
- e. Ask God to place a hedge of protection around you and to cover your life with the blood of Jesus
- f. Put on the full armor of God (Ephesians 6:10-18)
 - 1) Belt of Truth
 - 2) Breastplate of Righteousness
 - 3) Shoes of the Gospel of Peace
 - 4) Shield of Faith
 - 5) Helmet of Salvation
 - 6) Sword of the Spirit (*rhema* Word of God)
- g. Commit to watch always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit and to be perseverant in this for all the saints (Watchman)

10. <u>FOR THINE IS THE KINGDOM, THE POWER, AND THE GLORY FOREVER</u> (Prayer of Praise)

- a. Thank God for hearing and answering your prayers
- b. Make bold declarations of God's everlasting and victorious kingdom, His unmatched power, and His worthiness to receive all glory.
- c. Return to praise
