Satan: "God will never forgive you for this."

Our Counter-attack: "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."

Satan: "You can't do it!"

Our Counter-attack: "I can do all things through Him who strengthens me.' (Phil. 4:13, NASB)

Satan: "You're too far gone to be saved."
