## **3 KINDS OF DEATH**

	"For just as the body without the spirit is dead" (James 2:26)
	"And just as it is appointed for people to die once—and after this, judgment" (Heb. 9:27)
	"to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord."
	(2 Cor. 5:8, KJV)
>	Death - separation from
	"Therefore, just as sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, in this way death spread to all people, because all sinned." (Rom. 5:12)
	"For the wages of sin is death" (Rom. 6:23)
	"And you were dead in your trespasses and sins" (Eph. 2:1)
>	Death - separation from God
	"Blessed and holy is the one who shares in the first resurrection! The second death has no power over them" (Rev. 20:6)

"This is the second death, the lake of fire. And anyone whose name was

not found written in the book of life was thrown into the lake of fire." (Rev. 20:14b)

"Therefore I told you that you will die in your sins. For if you do not believe that I am he, you will die in your sins." (John 8:24)
