**HOW WE VOTE IS OUR ENDORSEMENT:**  
**BE BIBLICAL (Part 2)**

**Judges 17.6** *...all the people did whatever seemed right in their own eyes.*

**Judges 21.25** *...all the people did whatever seemed right in their own eyes.*

The two worldviews on the menu today are:

1. A PROGRESSIVE WORLDVIEW that spurns any other view beside its own view. (Intolerant)
2. A BIBLICAL WORLDVIEW where there are moral absolutes from the transcendent God. (To reject moral absolutes is to invite the erosion of a life or group of people.)

**NOTE:** For over 50 years our country has been binge drinking on the endless flow of *progressive thinking* and now our country is vomiting up the consequences of the “No God” worldview.

The Biblical/Christian worldviews include:

- Abortion is not a social issue, it's a **moral issue**.
- Same gender marriage is not a social issue, it's a **moral issue**.
- Confusion over the binary distinction between male and female is not a social issue, it's a **moral issue**. (God created male and female.)
- Heterosexual sin is not a social issue, it's a **moral issue**.

**Q:** Why would a person of faith in Jesus, who claims that they believe in the moral absolutes from the Bible and claim to love, follow, and serve God who is the Author of moral absolutes vote for anyone in ANY election who is aligned in opposition to the clear biblical understanding on moral issues?

**A:** Possible explanations as to the WHY:

- This politician has the same ethnicity as me.
- This politician is the same gender as me.
- This politician is a neighbor of mine.
- This politician is a part of the political party that I have been a part of for years.
- This politician promises to give us free stuff.
- This politician is going to take care of me.

Two thoughts for those who hold to the Biblical worldview.

1. Love all people regardless of what they believe and their identity in life. Don't loath the person with that political sign in their yard and sticker on their car. **Never hate anyone.**

**John 3.16** *"For God so loved the World."*

Every person we come in contact with is a person for whom Christ died. Others may hate; but not us.

2. As our world races to worship the creation instead of the CREATOR, don't lose heart, don't grow weary, and don't become a defeatist. God is still in charge regardless of elections. Engage the Truth of God's Word in your life over the culture.

**Isaiah 40.8** *The grass withers and the flowers fade, but the Word of our God stands forever.*

1. Vote with your Bible near you. (on your phone)
2. Pray with diligence.
3. God loves all people...even those with whom we disagree.
4. In our church we say, "Come as you are just don't stay that way."
5. Name the sin and it is forgivable because of the CROSS, SACRIFICE, BLOOD, AND LOVE OF JESUS.
