

When 1 John was written around AD 90, the life changing **TRUTH** of Jesus was rapidly spreading across the ancient world. Multitudes of people were becoming His followers. Churches were growing in number, size and influence. The Holy Spirit was working, and it was exciting. However, at the same time, Satan was working also. False teachers, recruited by the Evil One, were spreading **TRICKY** lies about Jesus that were leading people away from faith in Christ. It was a big problem back then, and it is an even bigger problem right now. You see, false spiritual teachers have been on the increase ever since those early days of Christianity. Their deceptive doctrines have resulted in a world full of false religions and cults. Additionally, their delusional lies have sown all kinds of ignorance, doubt and confusion among believers who are not well grounded in their faith by the teachings of the Bible. So, here's some super important questions for God that require some super clear responses from God. Specifically, how can we identify false teachers and their teachings? Why does it matter so much that we do? What resources do Christians have that can enable believers to discern Scriptural truth from Satan's tricks? We'll find out answers in today's study of 1 John 2:18-27.
