

The apostle John often referred to himself as the one *whom Jesus loved*. Now, John wasn't trying to be boastful or prideful when he made that statement. Rather, John was simply expressing his total joy and humble wonder that Jesus (God in human flesh) could, and would, actually love him so much. John was *stunned by the stunning love of God!* As long as he lived, John never got over his utter amazement and sheer delight that the perfect God would love him so perfectly. In 1 John 4:7-12, "the Apostle of love," (the nickname given John by other Christians), uses the word "love" 27 times to not only describe the love God has for us but also to tell us how to love one another in the family of God. Today as we study 1 John 4:7-10, we'll discover what it means for a follower of Jesus to *be loving others God's way!*
