## FOR THOUGHT & TALK

*In your small group take 5-10 minutes to review the main points of Pastor John's message. Discuss the following questions, taking your time as the Spirit leads, realizing you don't have to cover them all.*

1. Let's begin your small group with a "Big Picture" review. Start by asking a good reader to read aloud, with feeling and intentionality, the entire 25 verses of Jude. What surprised you about this little book? Did you realize there was that much in it? How have you sensed God speaking to you as we studied Jude each Sunday?
2. Okay now, diving more specifically into the **Christmas theme** and **Jude 24-25**, which one or two of God's presents for us, most stood out to you during the message? Why do you think the Spirit caused those one or two gifts to most resonate with you personally? What are some of the emotions you feel when you realize anew all that God the Father gives to His beloved children through the Lord Jesus Christ?
3. Jude pinpoints for us five specific gifts that the Lord would most like to receive from each one of us as His children. Describe what each gift is all about and some ways you can give those gifts to God. Can you identify some definite things the Holy Spirit is saying to you in terms of being a better gift giver to God? What does it tell us about God that He is even interested in getting gifts from us?
4. **PONDER. PRAISE. PROCLAIM. PEACE.** These 4 words were Pastor John's "takeaways." Why are these particularly important words for us to be reminded of and to take to heart during this time of year? How can living by them make for a much **Merrier Christmas**?
