FOR THOUGHT & TALK

Take no more than 5 minutes to quickly review the main points from Pastor John's message. As you discuss the questions, don't expect to answer all of them. Just discuss the ones your group would most like to explore together. Remember, the goal of your small group is to grow together relationally, to apply God's Word to our daily living, and to pray for one another and our church.

- 1. Why is it important that the first thing we need to know about our church, NCFF, is that this church belongs to Jesus, not to us? Why is it equally important to understand that NCFF isn't "the perfect church"? How did you feel about PJ's statement that though NCFF isn't perfect, it is (by God's grace), incredibly kind and loving? What do you love about NCFF? What could you do to help NCFF be even more kind and loving?
- 2. What does it mean that this specific local church (NCFF) is part of something much BIGGER? Jesus said in Matthew 16:18 ... I will build my church and the gates of Hell will not prevail against it. Acts 20:28 tells us Jesus purchased the church with His own blood. What do these verses show us about Jesus' feelings toward His church and plans for His church? If our goal is to think and feel like Christ, what do you suppose our thoughts and feelings toward the church should be?
- **3.** What does it mean that NCFF is a church family for engaging, not spectating? What has God given you, and how are you gifted/talented/blessed, to get engaged at NCFF? 1 Corinthians 12:4-7 reads, *In the church there are a variety of gifts, abilities, ministries, and impacts that God the Holy Spirit disperses amongst all of us. The church is like the parts of a human body, all serving and working together as one. Why is it good for you to get engaged, serving at church, and why is it good for the church to have you engaged in serving?*
- **4.** "GC3" stands for Great Commandment (Matthew 22:37-39), Great Confession (Matthew 16:15-16), Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20). Read aloud each one of these passages and then, in your own words, restate what each one of them means. Why are these verses so important for grasping what Jesus has in mind for His church to be and do?
- **5.** One at a time, state the six "S Experiences/Commitments" and explain what they mean. How will actually doing each one of the spiritual habits help build you as an individual Christian and our church together as a body of Jesus followers?
