4. What things excite you when you think of the future? What things make you apprehensive? How are Christians ultimately called to view the future both immediate and distant?
5. How do we rely on God in the midst of suffering and hardship? How might your faith compel you to take the right path over the easy one?
6. Have you ever been in a situation where you had to act in a way that might have seemed unorthodox for the sake of your faith? What did God teach you through that experience?
7. How might God call you to step out in courageous faith this summer?
