Jonah = Name in the Hebrew means Dove.

Jonah's assignment = Deliver the word of the Lord to his enemies to bring repentance, revival and restoration.

Why am I angry with God?

Jonah 4:1 -3 - But it displeased Jonah exceedingly, and he was very angry. And he prayed unto the LORD, and said, I pray thee, O LORD, was not this my saying, when I was yet in my country? Therefore I fled before unto Tarshish: for I knew that thou art a gracious God, and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repentest thee of the evil. Therefore now, O LORD, take, I beseech thee, my life from me; for it is better for me to die than to live.

- ▲ Jonah was furious with God for being God. He identified God's characteristics, yet he could not embrace the fact that God is sovereign. He was so blinded that he wanted to die, to end it all.
- ▲ When things do not according to our blueprint, moral standards and timetable, anger is the logical response.

<u>Anger</u> = a strong feeling of annoyance, displeasure, or hostility.

<u>Baker's Evangelical Dictionary of Biblical Theology defines anger</u> as a "strong emotional reaction of displeasure, often leading to plans for revenge or punishment."

▲ Anger affects your thinking, memory, creativity and weakens your concentration. As a result, thoughts become accusatory, exaggerated, and rigid. Assumptions become facts in your mind leading to irrational behavior-teamcorporatetraining.com

Uncontrolled anger is linked to:

- Depression
- ♦ Headaches
- ♦ Anxiety
- ♦ High blood pressure
- heart disease

▲ Anger is a spiritual vice. In professional wrestling the vice grip is a move in which the attacking wrestler squeezes the opponent's head with both hands. Think about your head being squeezed on both sides, you no longer have control but now is under subjection to that which is applying pressure.

Ephesians 4:31 - Get rid of all bitterness, **rage and anger**, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice.

<u>Psalms 37:8-9</u> (NIV) - Refrain from anger and turn from wrath; do not fret it leads only to evil. For those who are evil will be destroyed, but those who hope in the LORD will inherit the land.

Ephesians 4:26 - **Be angry and sin not**, do not let the sun go down on your wrath.

Galatian 5:20 - idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, **fits of rage**, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions

Jonah 4:4 - Why are you angry?

Proverbs 3:5-6 -Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto
thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.
Jonah 4:5 - He shifted his location but for the wrong reasons. He wanted to see what would happen. When we shift our position, it should be from a place of rebellion and disobedience to the posture of repentance and worship.
