STANDING IN THE GAP

Covering Great Apostle Randy, Pastor Gayle, Pastor Serrell, Head Deacon Debbie, Apostle Tommy and the Entire Mission Team

Father, in the name of Jesus, hallowed be Thy name. Thy Kingdom come and Thy will be done in Kenya and through every servant You have called and sent. Go before them, remain with them, work through them and bring them home safely. Give them strength, wisdom, discernment and fresh oil. Let Jesus be glorified; let souls be saved, bodies healed, captives delivered and lives transformed.

1. GOD GOES BEFORE THEM — NO CONTENTION AT THE GATE

Isaiah 45:2 — *“I will go before thee, and make the crooked places straight: I will break in pieces the gates of brass, and cut in sunder the bars of iron.”*

Psalms 24:7-10 — *“Lift up your heads, O ye gates... and the King of glory shall come in... The LORD strong and mighty, the LORD mighty in battle... the LORD of hosts, he is the King of glory. Selah.”*

- Go before them into every city, community, church, meeting and ministry location. Prepare the atmosphere and make every crooked place straight.
- No contention at airports, immigration, customs, with documents, luggage, transportation, accommodations, schedules, communication or ministry locations.
- Remove delays, confusion, interference and unnecessary complications. Let every God-ordained door open and every contrary plan fail.

KING OF GLORY, GO THROUGH EVERY GATE BEFORE THEM.

2. DIVINE PROTECTION — SECRET PLACE COVERING

Psalms 121:7-8 — *“The LORD shall preserve thee from all evil: he shall preserve thy soul. The LORD shall preserve thy going out and thy coming in from this time forth, and even for evermore.”*

Psalms 91:1-4 — *“He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty... He shall cover thee with his feathers... his truth shall be thy shield and buckler.”*

- Preserve them in the air, on the roads, in every vehicle, residence, ministry setting, crowded place and unfamiliar environment.
- Cover their bodies, minds, spirits, passports, belongings, finances and communications. Expose and dismantle every hidden snare.
- Give pilots and drivers wisdom and alertness; let aircraft, vehicles and equipment function properly. No accident, injury, violence, theft or evil occurrence.

THE LORD IS THEIR REFUGE AND FORTRESS.

3. DIVINE HEALTH, STRENGTH, FOOD AND REST

Exodus 23:25 — *“And ye shall serve the LORD your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee.”*

Isaiah 40:31 — *“But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength... they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.”*

- Bless everything they eat and drink. Protect them from sickness, infection, dehydration, digestive distress and unusual fatigue.
- Renew their strength daily; give restorative sleep and grace for travel, time changes and ministry demands.
- Let them awaken refreshed, healthy, clear-minded and ready for each day of the assignment.

4. THE TONGUE OF THE LEARNED — THE WORD SHALL HAVE FREE COURSE

Isaiah 50:4 — *“The Lord GOD hath given me the tongue of the learned, that I should know how to speak a word in season to him that is weary: he wakeneth morning by morning, he wakeneth mine ear to hear as the learned.”*

2 Thessalonians 3:1 — *“Finally, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have free course, and be glorified, even as it is with you.”*

- Wake them morning by morning. Give the right word, at the right time, for the right person.
- Give Great Apostle Randy, Pastor Gayle, Pastor Serrell, Apostle Tommy and every assigned minister supernatural utterance, clarity, boldness and precision.

- Let them know when to speak, pray, wait, move, remain silent, lay hands, encourage or simply love. Let translation and communication be clear.
- Let people not merely hear words — let them hear the voice of God through the Word.

LET THE WORD OF THE LORD RUN UNHINDERED AND BE GLORIFIED.

5. DEMONSTRATION OF THE SPIRIT — PREPARED HEARTS

Acts 4:29-30 — *“Grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word, by stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus.”*

Acts 16:14 — *“...whose heart the Lord opened, that she attended unto the things which were spoken of Paul.”*

- Confirm Your Word with salvation, healing, deliverance, restoration, reconciliation, miracles, signs and wonders. Let Jesus — not personalities — be seen.
- Open hearts before the team arrives. Prepare pastors, leaders, churches, families, young people, children and communities to receive what Heaven sends.
- Create divine appointments. Position the team at the right place and time. Let conversations become ministry moments and one encounter change a life.

6. WISDOM, UNITY, FAVOR AND OPEN DOORS

James 1:5 — *“If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God... and it shall be given him.”*

Psalms 5:12 — *“For thou, LORD, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt thou compass him as with a shield.”*

- Release supernatural wisdom and discernment concerning people, places, invitations, finances, schedules, ministry decisions and unexpected situations.
- Keep the team unified — no offense, misunderstanding or weariness creating friction. Let every gift complement another gift.
- Give favor with officials, airport personnel, ministry leaders, drivers, hosts, communities and churches. Let resources and relationships be released according to God’s purpose.

ONE TEAM. ONE ASSIGNMENT. ONE SPIRIT. ONE PURPOSE.

7. PROTECT THEIR FAMILIES AND HOMES AS THEY SERVE ON THE MISSION FIELD

Ezra 8:21 — *“...to seek of him a right way for us, and for our little ones, and for all our substance.”*

Isaiah 32:18 — *“And my people shall dwell in a peaceable habitation, and in sure dwellings, and in quiet resting places.”*

- As they serve on the mission field, cover spouses, children, grandchildren, parents, homes, property, finances, responsibilities and everything concerning them.
- Give their families peace. Secure the boundaries of their homes and let no emergency or disruption distract from the assignment.
- As they pour out in Kenya, give them confidence that You are faithfully watching over everything that concerns them.

8. NO BACKLASH — NO RETALIATION

Luke 10:19 — *“Behold, I give unto you power... over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.”*

Isaiah 54:17 — *“No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper... This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD... saith the LORD.”*

- No backlash, retaliation, counterattack, lingering oppression, sickness after ministry, disruption at home or confusion upon their return.
- No weapon formed against this team shall prosper. They shall return stronger — not depleted; refreshed — not drained; full — not empty.

9. DECLARE HIS GLORY — FRUIT THAT REMAINS

Psalms 96:3 — *“Declare his glory among the heathen, his wonders among all people.”*

John 15:16 — *“...I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain...”*

- Let Kenya encounter Jesus. Let the Gospel be preached, souls be saved, backsliders return, weary leaders be refreshed and churches strengthened.
- Let this mission produce fruit that remains: changed lives, restored families, strengthened ministries, Kingdom partnerships and testimonies that continue after the team returns.

THEY SHALL GO IN PEACE, MINISTER IN POWER, AND RETURN WITH TESTIMONY.

10. BREAD OF LIFE — STAY ON THE WALL

Isaiah 62:6-7 — *“I have set watchmen upon thy walls... which shall never hold their peace day nor night... and give him no rest, till he establish...”*

We at Bread of Life World Outreach Center will remain faithful to the assignment of intercession.

- While they go — WE STAND.
- While they travel — WE PRAY.
- While they minister — WE COVER.
- While they sleep — WE WATCH.
