- Read Acts 7:49-50. Why do you think Stephen quotes Isaiah in his preaching? Knowing that Stephen gets murdered after that sermon, what does that make you think about God?
- In theological terms God is both transcendent and near. As you look at the political landscape of America, which one of those two brings you the most comfort and why?
- Read Isaiah 66 from verse 15 through the end. In the midst of all the complexity, what is your biggest take-away of the coming Kingdom?

- Since God is in Heaven and earth is His footstool, lift up the needs of the nation to His throne.
