**Talk it Over**

- **Sermon in a Sentence:**

- *God dwells in an unlikely place,* (v.1-6)
- *...and announced an unexpected birth,* (v.7-14)
- *...and we will witness His unfolding plan.* (v.15-24)

- Which part of the sermon impacted you, gave insight, challenged you, encouraged you or helped give direction to life?
- Read Isaiah 57:15 and Isaiah 66:1-2. What do these passages tell us about the character of God? What emotion does it evoke?
- Read Acts 7:49-50. Why do you think Stephen quotes Isaiah in his preaching? Knowing that Stephen gets murdered after that sermon, what does that make you think about God?
- In theological terms God is both transcendent and near. As you look at the political landscape of America, which one of those two brings you the most comfort and why?
- Read Isaiah 66 from verse 15 through the end. In the midst of all the complexity, what is your biggest take-away of the coming Kingdom?

**Pray it Over:**

- Since God dwells with the humble, take some time and seek the Lord in humility.
- Since God is in Heaven and earth is His footstool, lift up the needs of the nation to His throne.
- Pray for one person who still needs to embrace Christ as Lord before eternity.
