## Session 12: The Father's Plan and Work in Our Salvation

## **Part 1: Defining salvation:**

- The word salvation simply means deliverance.
- The context of the use of the term dictates the nature of that salvation.
- Examples:
  - Saved from temporal enemies: Psalm 18:3
  - Saved from the temporal consequences: Proverbs 28:18
  - Saved in a corporate sense: Isaiah 45:17
  - Saved in the individual sense: Isaiah 45:22
  - Saved from wrath in the eternal sense: Romans 5:9
  - Saved from eternal destruction: 1 Corinthians 3:15

## Part 2: Three common ways to speak about the believer's salvation:

- Salvation from the penalty of sin: The believer's justification
  - o John 5:24
  - Romans 5:1
- **Salvation from the power of sin:** The believer's growth in spiritual maturity
  - o Romans 6:6-14
  - Romans 12:1-2
- Salvation from the presence of sin: The believer's future glorification
  - Romans 5:9
  - 1 Corinthians 15:50-54
  - Revelation 21:4

Part 3: The Father's Plan and Work: 2 Corinthians 5:18 "All things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ..."

- First: The Father carefully planned every detail of reconciliation:
  - Ephesians 1:3-11
    - Chosen to a final status of holy and without blame: "He hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him..."
    - Predestined to adoption: "Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself..."
    - Fully accepted: "He hath made us accepted in the beloved..."
    - **Redeemed and Forgiven:** "Redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins..."

- United in One Body: "He might gather together in one all things in Christ..."
- Predestined to an inheritance: "In whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated..."
- o Romans 8:28-32
  - Comforted in all circumstances: "All things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose..."
  - Predestined to conformity to the image of Christ: "He also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son..."
  - He has guaranteed that He will finish everything He has started in our salvation: "How shall he not with him also freely give us all things?
- Second: The Father has graciously revealed that plan since the fall:
  - Luke 1:68-70
  - o Acts 3:18-21
- Third: The Father graciously accomplished every detail of that plan through Christ's work:
  - o Isaiah 53:10-11
  - Galatians 4:4-5
  - 1 John 4:9-10, 14
  - Philippians 2:8
  - Matthew 26:39
- Fourth: The Father sent the Spirit to comfort, seal, indwell, and baptize us into Christ:
  - o John 14:16
  - o John 15:26
- Fifth: The Father wisely and lovingly cares for His children to bring them to spiritual maturity: Hebrews 12:6-11
- Sixth: The Father graciously keeps those whom He has saved by His love and power:
  - o John 10:27-30
  - o Romans 8:31-33

## Part 4: The blessing of the Father's Plan and Work

- **His love:** He is the initiator of our salvation.
- **His grace and forbearance:** Though we have sinned against Him and are at enmity with Him, He pursued us.
- **His trustworthiness:** He promised and fulfilled every detail of His plan.
- **His power:** He keeps us once He has saved us.
- **His affection:** He cares for us as a loving father.
