<sup>18</sup> Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. <sup>19</sup> Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

Talmid: "a student of teacher or philosopher"

You chose to be a disciple, your life has 3 goals

1. To be with your Rabbi (Jesus invited his disciples to "be with him")
2. To become like your Rabbi (Copy their tone of voice, mannerisms, ect.)
3. To do as your Rabbi (train under, so that you can be one yourself)
