

SIMILARITIES BETWEEN JUDE AND HOME ALONE

SUMMARY OF HOME ALONE:

A YOUNG BOY MUST DEFEND HIS HOME AGAINST TWO BUMBLING BURGLARS (INTRUDERS) USING ELABORATE TRAPS AND ULTIMATELY LEARNS THE VALUE OF FAMILY.

SUMMARY OF JUDE:

A YOUNG CHURCH (OR CHURCHES) IS ENCOURAGED TO DEFEND THE FAITH AGAINST NUMEROUS FALSE TEACHERS (INTRUDERS) USING THE HOLY SPIRIT TO GUIDE THEM TO TRUTH AND HOLY LIVING AND ULTIMATELY RE-LEARNING THE VALUE OF GOD'S MERCY AND GRACE.

SUMMARY OF PETER'S LETTERS

1 Peter: Stand firm in the faith while enduring present suffering and waiting for future glory

2 Peter: Grow in knowledge and practice of the faith to combat false teachers ... While waiting for future glory

WHAT DO WE KNOW ABOUT JUDES

ONE OF JESUS' FOUR HALF-BROTHERS

Matt. 13:55 — "Is not this the Carpenter's son? Is not his mother called Mary? And are not his brothers James and Joseph and Simon and Judas?"

Mark 6:3 — "Is not this the Carpenter, the son of Mary and Brother of James and Joses and Judas and Simon?"

DENIED JESUS WAS MESSIAH BEFORE HIS DEATH

JOHN 7:5 - FOR NOT EVEN HIS BROTHERS BELIEVED IN HIM.

WHAT DO WE KNOW ABOUT JUDES

BELIEVED JESUS WAS MESSIAH AFTER RESURRECTION

Acts 1:14 - All these with one accord were devoting themselves to prayer, together with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and his brothers.

MHAT DO WE KNOW ABOUT JUDES

LIKELY SERVED AS A TRAVELING MISSIONARY

1 Cor. 9:5 - Do we not have the right to take along a believing wife, as do the other apostles and the brothers of the Lord and Cephas?

EMPHASIS IN JUDE 1: THOSE WHOM GOD HAS CALLED TO HIMSELF ARE LOVED BY HIM AND KEPT UNTIL THE DAY OF SALVATION.

COMPARISON OF JUDE 4 TRANSLATIONS

- ESV "PERVERT THE GRACE OF GOD INTO SENSUALITY"
- CSB "TURNING THE GRACE OF OUR GOD INTO SENSUALITY"
- NET "TURNED THE GRACE OF OUR GOD INTO A LICENSE FOR EVIL"
- NIV "PERVERT THE GRACE OF OUR GOD INTO A LICENSE FOR IMMORALITY"
- NLT "SAYING THAT GOD'S MARVELOUS GRACE ALLOWS US TO LIVE IMMORAL LIVES"

- Wait for Christ's Mercy
- KEEP YOURSELVES IN GOD'S LOVE

3. RESCUE

- Show Mercy to Doubters
- Don't give up on those led astray
- MERCY WITH FEAR
