Covenants are the framework of God's mission...the way He chooses to relate to humanity and restore what was broken in the Garden.

Covenants originate in the heart of God, not in human initiative.

1. The Noahic Covenant (Genesis 9)

- Promise: Never again destroy the earth with a flood.
- Sign: Rainbow.
- Importance: God commits to sustaining the world so redemption can unfold.

2. Abrahamic Covenant

(Gen.12, 15, 17)

- Promise: Land, descendants, blessing to all nations.
- Sign: Circumcision.
- Importance: Launches God's plan to redeem the world through a chosen family.

3. The Mosaic Covenant (Exo. 19–24)

- Promise: Israel will be God's treasured possession and kingdom of priests.
- Sign: Sabbath.
- Importance: Gives Israel a way to live as God's distinct people.

4. The Davidic Covenant (2 Samuel 7)

- Promise: A king from David's line will reign forever.
- Importance: Points directly to Jesus as the eternal King.

5. The New Covenant

(Jer. 31; Luke 22; Heb. 8–10)

- Promise: Forgiveness, new hearts, God's Spirit within us.
- Sign: The cup (Jesus' blood).
- Importance: The pinnacle of all covenants...fulfilled in Christ.

Covenants teach us to be:

- Faithful
- Forgiving
- Committed
- Truthful
- Sacrificial

Covenants Reveal God's Pursuit

Every covenant is God moving
toward broken people,
not away from them.

Covenants Are Missional

The Abrahamic covenant’s
“blessing to the nations” becomes
the Great Commission.

Covenants Are Relational, Not Ritualistic
