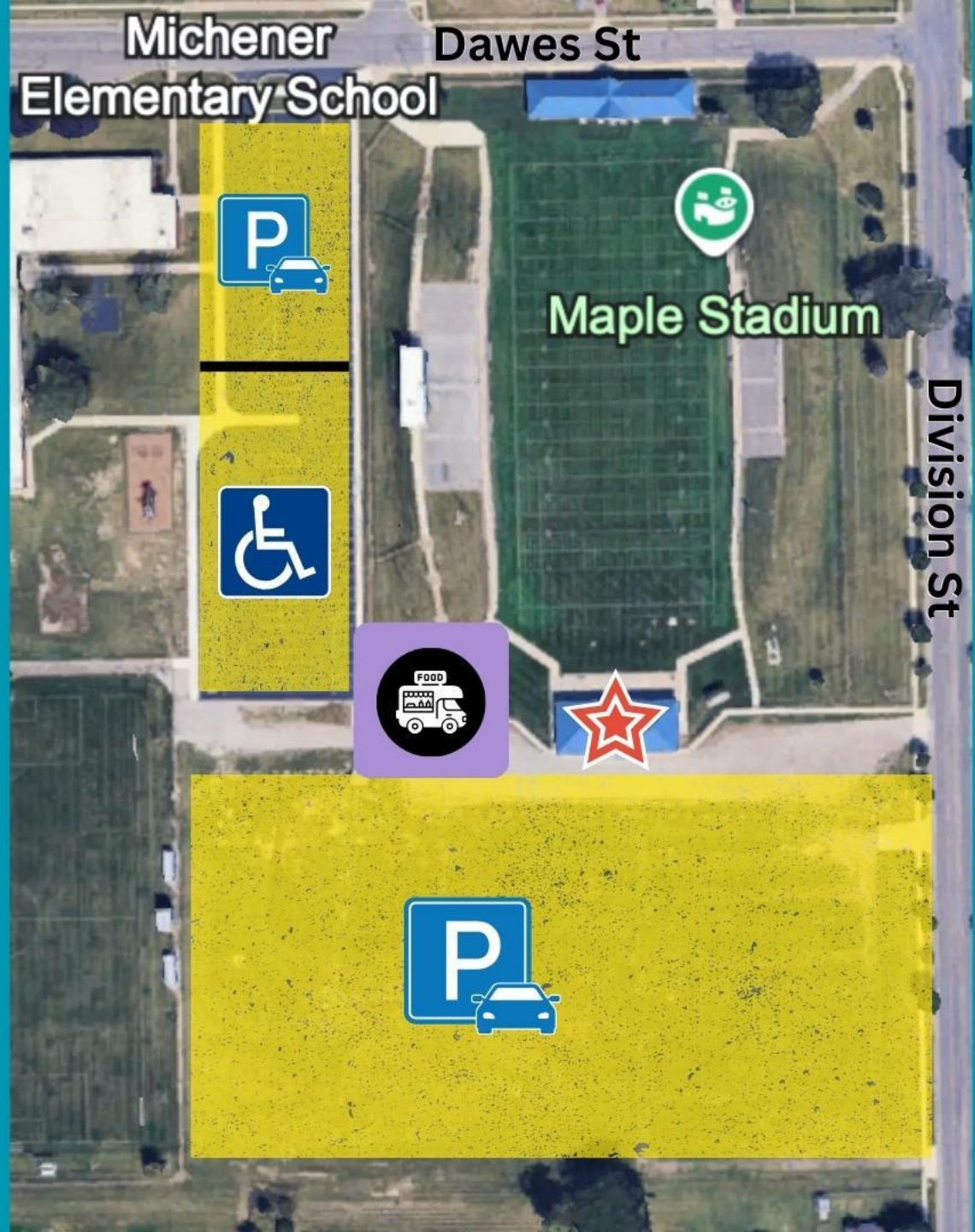

UNSHAKEABLE CONTENTMENT

[Philippians 4:10-13]

Contentment isn't having
everything you want in life...

rather, it's wanting Christ more
than everything else in life.

1Ti 6:6-9 (NIV)

UNSHAKEABLE PARTNERSHIP

[Philippians 4:14-18]

Mat 6:19-21 (NIV)

19 "Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moths and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal.

20 But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moths and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal.

21 For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

Pro 11:24-25 (NIV)

24 One person gives freely, yet gains even more; another withholds unduly, but comes to poverty.

25 A generous person will prosper; whoever refreshes others will be refreshed.

There is a BIG difference between...

the 'prosperity gospel'

&

the 'provision Gospel'!

UNSHAKEABLE PROVISION

[Philippians 4:19-23]

God doesn't promise to fund
our preferences...

He promises to meet our needs.

Mat 6:33-34 (NIV)

33 But **seek first his kingdom and his righteousness**, and all these things will be given to you as well.

34 **Therefore do not worry about tomorrow**, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own.

KEY TAKEAWAYS

Contentment is learned, not inherited.

Generosity is partnership, not charity.

God provides according to His riches,
not our circumstances.

The gospel creates a community where
needs are met and lives are changed.

The Philippians didn't give because Paul was in need, they gave because the gospel was worth it.

What is the Gospel worth to you?

WHEN we give... may we ALWAYS...

- Give **joyfully** — because God is worthy.
- Give **faithfully** — because the mission matters.
- Give **sacrificially** — because eternity is real.
- Give **consistently** — because partnership is ongoing.

And where is God calling us to partner
more deeply in His mission?
