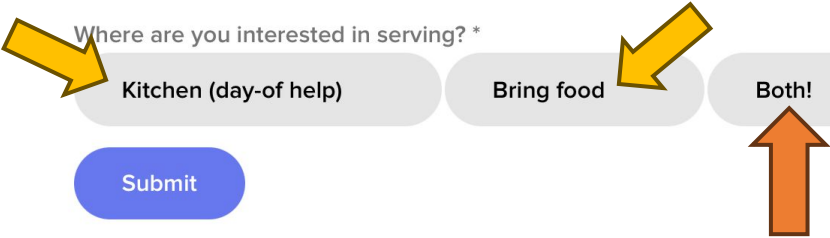

8 Things We Learn About Suffering & Persecution From Peter...

1Pe 4:12 (NIV)

12 Dear friends, do not be surprised at the fiery ordeal that has come on you to test you, as though something strange were happening to you.

1. There should be an expectation for suffering and persecution in the life of a believer.

John 15:18-20 (NIV)

18 "If the world hates you, keep in mind that it hated me first.

19 If you belonged to the world, it would love you as its own. As it is, you do not belong to the world, but I have chosen you out of the world. That is why the world hates you.

20 Remember what I told you: 'A servant is not greater than his master.' If they persecuted me, they will persecute you also...

1Pe 4:12 (NIV)

12 Dear friends, do not be surprised at the fiery ordeal that has come on you **to test you**, as though something strange were happening to you.

2. There is a good and Godly PURPOSE for suffering and persecution in the life of a believer.

1Pe 4:13 (NIV)

2Co 4:16-17 (ESV)

16 So we do not lose heart. Though our outer self is wasting away, our inner self is being renewed day by day.

17 For this **light momentary affliction** is preparing for us an **eternal weight of glory** beyond all comparison

1Pe 4:14 (NIV)

14 If you are insulted for the name of Christ, you are blessed, because the Spirit of glory and of God rests upon you.

5. There is a COMFORT that God provides in the midst of your suffering & persecution.

Psa 34:18 (NIV)

18 The LORD is near to the brokenhearted
and saves the crushed in spirit.

1Pe 4:15 (NIV)

15 If you suffer, **it should not be as** a murderer or thief or any other kind of criminal, or even as a meddler.

1Pe 4:16 (NIV)

16 However, if you suffer as a Christian, do not be ashamed, but praise God that you bear that name.

19 So then, those who suffer according to God's will should commit themselves to their faithful Creator and continue to do good.
