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Romans 1: 1-7

Authorship:

- Written by Paul, around AD 57, near the end of his third missionary journey.
- Penned in Corinth, delivered by Phoebe (Romans 16:1–2).
- Paul has not been to Rome yet — this is a pastoral letter to a church he didn't plant.

Audience:

- A mixed church of Jewish and Gentile (Greek) believers.
- Tension existed between these groups after Jews were expelled from Rome & later returned.
- Romans is Paul's theological masterpiece to unify a divided church.

Purpose:

- To present the **full gospel**, clearly and systematically.
- To unify believers around the **truth** of Christ.
- To prepare Rome as a launch pad for Paul's **mission** to Spain.
- To show how the gospel creates a **new humanity...**
a people shaped by grace.

KEY WORDS: Found in Romans more than any other book...

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- **Faith (39x)** [*Gk. pistis*] – “belief, trust, and reliance on God – who He is and what He promises”
- **Wrath (12x)** [*Gk. orge*] – “God’s righteous anger, His divine indignation and just punishment in response to human sin”

We must understand the **bad news**...

so that, we can appreciate the **good news!**

Rom 1:18-19 (NIV)

18 The wrath of God is being revealed from heaven against all the godlessness and wickedness of people, **who suppress the truth by their wickedness,**

19 since what may be known about God is plain to them, because God has made it plain to them.



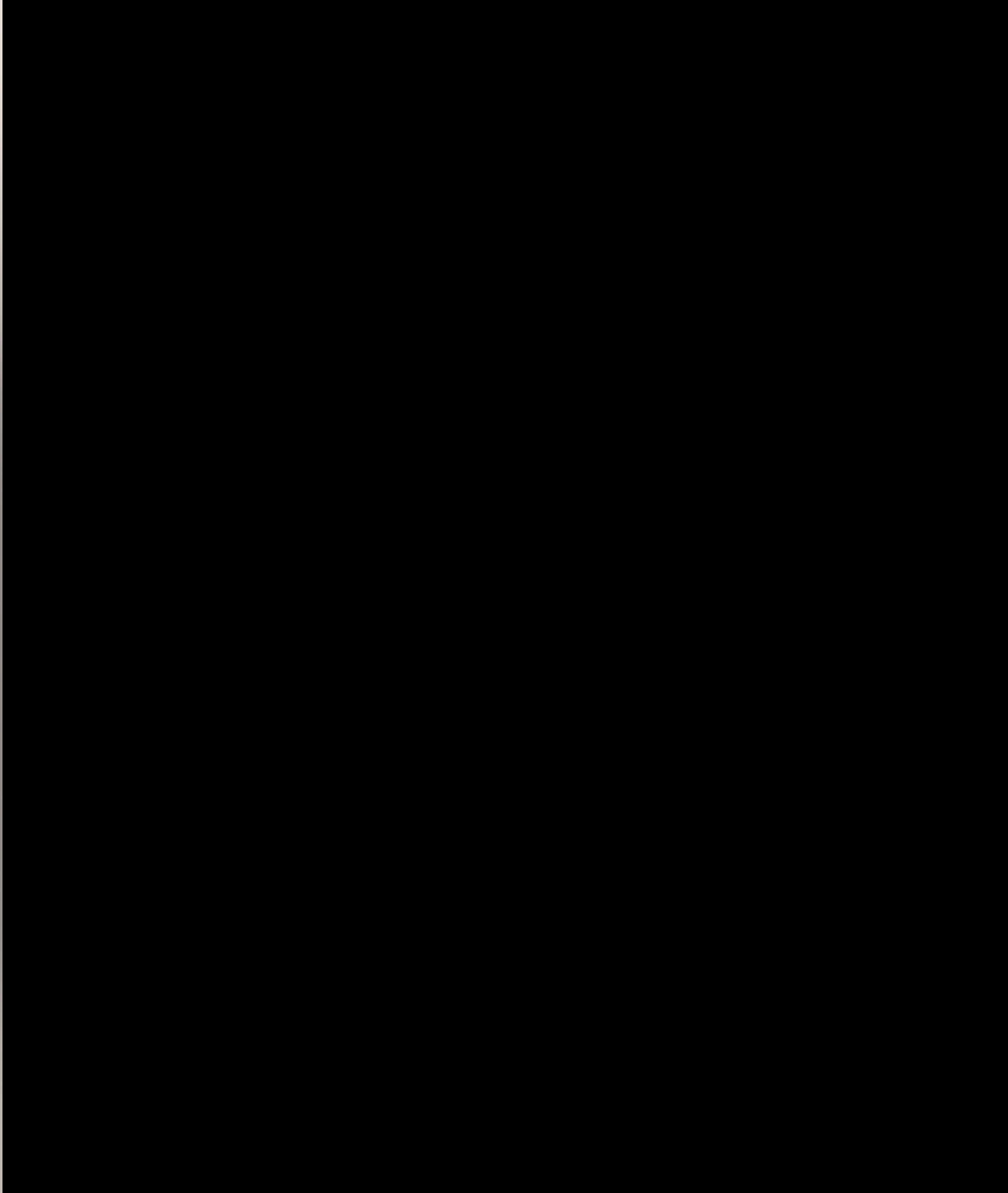
The “BAD” categories of humanity...

1. The Unrighteous.
2. The Self-Righteous.
3. The Over-Righteous.

The problem isn't that people

15 That is why I am so eager to preach the gospel also to you who are in Rome.

16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes...
