

**A Thoughtful Church**

**-1 Corinthians 8:1-13**

In this passage Paul addresses the issue of eating food sacrificed to an idol and how Christians ought to love one another.

**-Knowledge and Love (v.1-3)**

- Knowledge puffs up (v.1)
- Love builds up (v.1)
- Knowledge is superficial (v.2)
- Love is supernatural (v.3)

  - With Christ
