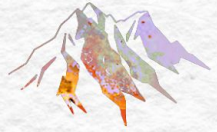

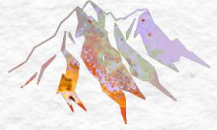
Matthew 7:7-12

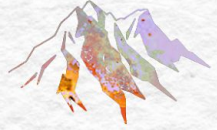

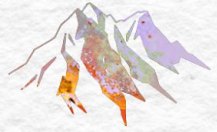




Ask... God Gives Good Things To Those Who Ask Him vs. 9-11



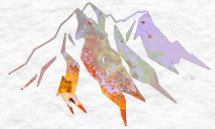
