#### Matthew 19:3-11 CSB

Some Pharisees approached him to test him. They asked, "Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife on any grounds?" <sup>4</sup> "Haven't you read," he replied, "that he who created them in the beginning made them male and female, <sup>5</sup> and he also said, 'For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two will become one flesh'? <sup>6</sup> So they are no longer two, but one flesh. Therefore, what God has joined together, let no one separate."

"So in the one-flesh union of marriage, all the boundaries between a man and a woman fall away, and the married couple comes together completely, as long as they both shall live. #### 1 Corinthians 7:12-16

<sup>12</sup> But I (not the Lord) say to the rest: If any brother has an unbelieving wife and she is willing to live with him, he must not divorce her. <sup>13</sup> Also, if any woman has an unbelieving husband and he is willing to live with her, she must not divorce her husband.<sup>14</sup> For the unbelieving husband is made holy by the wife, and the unbelieving wife is made holy by the husband. Otherwise your children would be unclean, but as it is they are holy.<sup>15</sup> But if the unbeliever leaves, let him leave. A brother or a sister is not bound in such cases. God has called you to live in peace. <sup>16</sup> Wife, for all you know, you might save your husband. Husband, for all you know, you might save your wife.
