

## Sowing For A Supernatural Harvest

Genesis 12:2

**And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing:**

Are you teachable? That's the first question I have for you. Teaching comes with **change**.

The second question is: What type of financial system do you have set up in your life that's not working? Whatever it is, let's remove it.

There are some things you've been carrying and have learned over the years that haven't been working as it should, but it's time for that to be cancelled. If you've been doing the same thing and nothing has changed, get rid of it. I'm here to help us do it.

**Isaiah 48:17 (KJV) says, Thus saith the Lord, thy Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; I am the Lord thy God which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by the way that thou shouldest go.**

**Isaiah 48:17 (AMP) Thus says the Lord, your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel: I am the Lord your God, Who teaches you to profit, Who leads you in the way that you should go.**

Notice it says "**teacheth thee to profit**" and not teacheth thee to **fail** or teacheth thee to **stay at the same level**.

This means we can be taught how to profit. But again, are you teachable?

I'm teaching us how to sow and grow wealth. We must follow the Bible's way to prosperity.

Many people will try to talk us out of it. They will say you're giving your money away, but really you are sowing your money, not giving anything away.

We must have expectation. Then, we will have visitation. Then, we will have manifestation. Then, we will have demonstration. Then, we will have creation. I'm looking for us to have this experience in our lives.

I'm teaching this so that God's grace and anointing to sow and grow wealth will be on us.

Say this with me, **Holy Spirit, develop a pure desire in me to sow**

### Why Sow

Sowing is a blessing from God to make you **rich**.

It's a divine way to prosperity that Satan has tried to turn into something else.

For years, **force and fear** have been involved with giving in the Church.

It is sad that the majority of churchgoers can say they've experienced ministers saying almost anything in the pulpit to pressure them to give. That shouldn't be!

Giving should be about **faith and cooperation**, not fear and force.

When we are taught properly and recognize that sowing is what we are supposed to do to grow, no one will have to twist your arms to do it.

Sowing aims to take you to another level and into a greater dimension of walking in the blessings of God.

We see this in Genesis 12:1. God taught Abraham the principles of sowing and trained him to be a Sower.

**Genesis 12 says: Now the Lord said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee,**

That's the beginning of Abraham's training.

Brothers and sisters understand this: To be a bona fide Sower, you will have to leave some things and some people behind.

Notice, the Lord also added where Abraham would be going.

**He said, "unto a land that I will show you."**

What type of land is God talking about?

If we look at Deuteronomy 8:7-10, it tells us:

**7 For the Lord thy God bringeth thee into a good land, a land of brooks of water, of fountains and depths that spring out of valleys and hills;**

**8 A land of wheat, and barley, and vines, and fig trees, and pomegranates; a land of oil olive, and honey;**

**9 A land wherein thou shalt eat bread without scarceness, thou shalt not lack anything in it; a land whose stones are iron, and out of whose hills thou mayest dig brass.**

**10 When thou hast eaten and art full, then thou shalt bless the Lord thy God for the good land which he hath given thee.**

There are **three** types of lands you can go into:

The land of not enough

The land of just enough

The land of more than enough

Sowing will take you into the land of more than enough:

— a good land, a land of harvest, without scarcity, flowing with milk and honey.

You should be living in the land of more than enough.

You should never lack anything you want or anything you desire, dream, or see.

Too many Christians are living in lack and scarceness.

But that's not of God, that's of religion and tradition.

When we look at Genesis 12:2-3, we see a demonstration of sowing.

It states in verse 2 And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great;

verse 3 And thou shalt be a blessing: and I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee:

and in thee shall all the families of the earth be blessed.

**God said, "I'll bless them that bless you."**

That's a demonstration of sowing.

He was telling Abraham, "Teach them to sow like I'm teaching you to do, and when they sow into you, I will sow into them."

The type of blessings you see in Abraham's life couldn't have happened without sowing.

**In Genesis 13:2, it says: Abram was very rich in cattle, in silver, and in gold.**

Again, this cannot happen without sowing. Why? Because God would have to scrap His entire system.

If Abraham was not a Sower, a lot of other things God tells us in His word would be a lie.

And we know God is not a man that He should lie. If He said it, He'll make it good.

**Numbers 23:19 says, God *is* not a man, that he should lie; neither the son of man, that he should repent: hath he said, and shall he not do *it*? or hath he spoken, and shall he not make it good?**
