### Wanting, Wishing, and Waiting

### The Blessing of Plenteousness Versus Empty-Handedness

Can you do much of anything, including work for God, with empty hands with hands that are empty of finances? No, it takes money to operate in the earth. And God wants to fill your hands with the finances you need to accomplish the tasks He assigns and to live well as His representative. He wants to give you handfuls of "**plenty.**"

Your hands need to be full in order to fulfill God's purposes.

Money has a purpose, a main purpose. And that purpose is the propagation of the Good News of the Gospel — reaping the harvest of men's souls, making disciples, and teaching all nations.

In order to begin walking in this realm of financial blessing,

**First**, you're going to have to understand money's first purpose: the propagation of the Gospel and the saving of souls.

**Second**, you're going to have to be firmly established in the will of God concerning your financial prosperity.

He doesn't want you wearing His Name as His child and living like He doesn't take care of you!

This verse in Deuteronomy 15 shows us the association between freedom and having something in your hands. God associates finances with freedom.

1. God did not intend that you "go out" of spiritual captivity empty-handed.

3. God wants your hands full of wealth so that He can call on you as a co-laborer with Him to help finance His work to reap the precious fruit of the earth.

Some Christians frown at this message because they say that their needs are met, and they are content; they don't want anything else. But they should hear the message and receive it so God can use their hands for His purposes.

If we would permit the Holy Spirit to impress upon our spirit that this is not just some off-the-wall message, we would rise to a higher level in our understanding, in our faith, and in our ability to receive what God has so freely given.
