**Amos 3:7**

There are certain secrets that God reveals to His prophets. And the full mystery of the covenant can't be revealed to you unless you permit God to reveal it to you through His prophets. Understanding the mysteries of the covenant releases covenant abundance in your life. Along with your study, the prophet's speaking to you can cause the mysteries to become revelation, and then the rain of abundance—of having more than enough—comes.

The congregation's word of completion is in the prophet's mouth.

The revelation that we receive combined with the word from the mouth of the prophet will put us in a different category where receiving from God is concerned.
