

Faith and Your Seed

Luke 17:5-6

⁵ And the apostles said unto the Lord, Increase our faith.

⁶ And the Lord said, If ye had faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye might say unto this sycamine tree, Be thou plucked up by the root, and be thou planted in the sea; and it should obey you.

It's not an increase in faith you need. All we need is the seed principle and to understand how it works. The seed has authority over plenty, but it's up to you to catch the revelation. Therefore, study the seed. Your faith is already working. You don't need more faith.

As Jesus explained in Luke 17, even if it's as small as a grain of mustard seed, an entire tree can obey you and be uprooted.

Now, what about our debt and lack? Will it take more faith to uproot it and make it move as you want?

No, it won't. In the same way, if your faith is as small as a grain of mustard seed, it'll move.

It's not about **increasing** our faith to get out of debt and lack.

It's about our **FAITH NEEDING** a **SEED SOWN** to participate in kingdom finances.

Faith without a seed won't work.

Without first having faith and a seed come together, our harvest can't become pregnant with manifestation. Faith can't be **impregnated** without a seed, and a seed can't be **impregnated** without faith. Faith must work in the womb of a seed to impregnate it with the manifestations of the promises of God.

It's financial intercourse, and it cannot take place without the companionship of faith and a seed.

Think about that.

Our seed has a womb, and when we sow in faith, babies (**dreams and manifestations**) are born.

God Watches Over His Seed

Jeremiah 1:12 says, Then said the Lord unto me, Thou hast well seen: for I will hasten my word to perform it.

The **Word of God** and the **seed** are **synonymous**.

When God said "I will hasten [meaning **to watch**] my word to perform it" in Jeremiah 1:12, He's also saying He will watch over **His seed** to perform it.

It's important for our heart, soul, and inner being to hear, trust, and understand that when we sow a seed we're sowing the Word and God is watching over it.

A financial seed sown is **full of mercy, grace, righteousness, and understanding** because God told you to do it.

YOU'RE NOT PLANTING EMPTY MONEY WHEN GOD'S HAND IS ON IT.

2 Corinthians 1:20 says, All the promises of God are yea and amen.

God is saying, "I promise if you sow, **I'll see to it that you have a harvest**. You'll never have to wait for anything anymore." If you're expecting something and it doesn't show up tomorrow, **don't panic**.

As a bonafide Sower with God watching over your seed to perform it, **richness cannot escape you**.

Isaiah 55:10-11 says, For as the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and maketh it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater:

11 So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.

You may be thinking: I'm alone. I'm single. I'm a widow. My job situation isn't too good.

Or, I have to get my children some things, first.

But do you remember what we learned (in **Genesis 26:12**) from Isaac's example of sowing in famine land?

Genesis 26:12 (KJV) Then Isaac sowed in that land, and received in the same year an hundredfold: and the LORD blessed him.

Seed sowing does not respect the type of condition you're in or how long you've been in it,

It is designed to supernaturally change your condition to produce in your favor.

Despite where you may live, the enemy cannot stop you.

Understand that **no one can stop a Sower** — not the government, the economy, politicians, haters, naysayers, religious folks, or denominations.

Some folks are trying to shut me down from every angle, but they can't, I keep sowing.

One of the main things that will rob a seed is the lack of understanding (which I'm clearing up in these studies).

We must have an understanding of the pivotal power of a seed and how precious it is.

I can attest to the fact that if you want to sow (**despite your condition**),

God will always give you a seed — a seed full of mercy, grace, and righteousness.

Once God gives you seed, you're going to have to sow... and sow and sow!

As you break through the sowing flow, the seed keeps on coming. You just have to get in there and start. I'll say this again: seed sowing does not respect the condition you're in! Have you truly realized that?

We must take hold of this revelation in our heart. No matter where you are right now, God has you here for a reason.

No matter what your financial condition is and no matter how long it has been that way, by the revelation of this teaching and the anointing on your life as you make it a personal practice, you're set up for a change of condition.

Now of course, you can't sow what you don't have, but you can't have what you don't sow.

God will never permit a seed Sower to be mocked **in their finances.**

Galatians 6:7, says, "God is not mocked".

Galatians 6:7 (KJV) Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

Galatians 6:7 (AMP) Do not be deceived *and* deluded *and* misled; God will not allow Himself to be sneered at (scorned, disdained, or mocked by mere pretensions or professions, or by His precepts being set aside.) [He inevitably deludes himself who attempts to delude God.] For whatever a man sows, that *and* that only is what he will reap.

Well, the seed is of God, so just as God is not mocked, the seed is not mocked.

God will not permit you to keep sowing and not manifest. **Due season must come.**

When you read **Galatians 6:9**, it says: And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not. Don't faint.

Sowing is the well-doing we see in that verse. Let us not be weary in sowing. **DUE SEASON HAS TO COME.**
