Luke 6:10

And after looking around at them all he said to him, "Stretch out your hand." And he did so, and his hand was restored.

You have to be honest, acknowledge and yield up the withered thing before it is healed...

Paul - greatest Christian ever?

- Corinthian Leaders:
 - o "Paul, can't even speak well... listen to us instead."
- Paul Response:
 - "I could speak out of my exceedingly great revelations... but I choose to boast instead in my weaknesses."

Thorn in the Flesh:

- A physical ailment
- An emotional or spiritual weakness (anger, enneagram 8)
- Massive amounts of people who want to kill him

"In order to keep my from being conceited - God allowed this..."

Pride = acting in my ability independently of God

Humility = being pressed to the ground: depending on God

ILL. A small drowning man - 4 grown men afraid of getting drowned.

- Why?
- Was the drawing man super smart?
- Super strong?
- He was <u>in desperate need</u> and that equated to a kind of ability that was uncommon
- This is a negative example, but if you take it in inverse
- Our KNOWLEDGE of OUR DESPERATION/LIMITS/NEED equate to power...

Knowledge of our desperate NEED EQUATES TO POWER

You won't understand NEED until you understand LIMITS

When we are limited we look & listen for the One who isn't

1. LIMITS ARE A GIFT

2 Corinthians 4:7-11

7 But we have this <u>treasure</u> in jars of clay to show that this all-surpassing power is from God and not from us. 8 We are hard pressed on every side, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair; 9 persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed. 10 We always carry around in our body the death of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be revealed in our body. 11 For we who are alive are always being given over to death for Jesus' sake, so that his life may also be revealed in our mortal body.

Remember the sabbath day, and keep it holy. Six days you shall labor and do all your work. But the seventh day is a sabbath to the Lord your God; you shall not do any work—you, your son or your daughter, your male or female slave, your livestock, or the alien resident in your towns. For in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that is in them, but rested the seventh day; therefore the Lord blessed the sabbath day and consecrated it. (**Exod. 20:8-11**)

- Jesus tells NT religious leaders -
 - Man wasn't made for sabbath (to keep a law)
 - Sabbath was made for man (as a gift)

Mark 2:27

Then he said to them, "The Sabbath was made for man, not man for the Sabbath.

2. LIMITS ARE A DELIGHT

2 Corinthians 12:7-10

- Show pictures off my phone
- Would I show pictures of my limitations/weaknesses?
 - o "Check this out!"
- That is what Paul is talking about

We may not "verbally" boast in our weaknesses much, but a way we can "boast" is to be honest with ourselves about our limitations and weaknesses - and work within those human and God limitations.

3. LIMITS ARE A DOOR

We think of limits as a wall or a STOPPERS

What if they were doorways and go-ers?

Apostle Paul stronger writer - weak speaker, physically small, in prison

- Those limitations led to him writing ¾ of New Testament!
- We can record voice now, but they didn't back then
- Billions of people benefitting from Paul's limitations

Our hands have opposable thumbs, which means we are designed to handle things, do delicate work, pick up objects and use them. We might be more limited in speed

than a cheetah, but our thumbs allow us to become creators and artists. <u>The limit tells</u> us who we are and what we're meant to do. - The body is God's Design

THAT OPEN THE WAY TO

- Humility
- Depth of communion with Jesus
- Revelation of Jesus
- His Direction
 - He is using limits to get you to a certain path a road
- His Mission
 - How do I use what is in my hand instead of chasing what isn't
- His Power

The more there is of <u>us</u>, the <u>less</u> there is of God. - Eugene Peterson
