**INTRO**: videos games w/ friends, can't beat level; Working on our cars in college, call out for my friend's dad Many of us have temptation/struggle, where freq fail Trials/struggle to find rest, contentment, and life.

[Prop: Through the cross Jesus passed the test that Adam and every human fails, and bore the condemnation of our failures to bring us back into covenant with God.]

Jesus succeeded where Adam & WE! failed.

# I. We have all failed to obey God. Humans are covenant breakers.

- -Covenant is the reason Paul can say v. 12, 18-19
- -belong to Adam get Adam stuff: death, sin, condemnation
- -belong to Christ get Christ stuff: life & righteousness

**APOL:** Not fair? - families impact children, representatives' impact those they lead - bizarre world; w/o covenant you lose JC's blessings

## A. Defining Covenant

- -the backbone of the story of the Bible are the covenants
- O. 22. What is a covenant?
- A. An agreement between two or more persons.

-parties (God & man), the promises/blessings, commands, curse,

#### B. God's Covenant with Adam

- 1. The Covenant of Works/Adam/Creation
- -the "one man" is Adam (name=man), and Paul is recalling Gen 1-3
- -Gen 1-2 God made & set Adam and Eve in the garden
- -Adam was given dominion, living at peace with God & Creation

- -blessing: mandate (Gen 1:28) -provision of all their needs (2:16), perfect fellowship with God (3:8)
- -command: do not eat of the Tree of Knwldg of Good & Evil (2:17a)
- -curse: in the day you eat of it you shall surely die (2:17b)

**ILLUS:** woman walking down the aisle in white dress = wedding

### C. Adam fails the test, and broke the covenant

- -the Serpent/Satan came and tempted, and Adam failed the test
- -broken covenant between humans and God (Hos 6:7)
- -"sin came into the world through one man" (Rom 5:12)
- -"many were made sinners" (Rom 5:19a)

-Paul's use of "sin" - malevolent force

**ILL**: Thom. Bost., "I would have no friends in Scotland if men knew my inmost thoughts".

**APP:** go to Dr no use pretend only one thing wrong

-God drove the man and woman out of the garden (Gen 3:12)
-and he placed two cherubim (angelic beings) w/flaming swords
'death through sin' (Rom 5:12) 'condemnation for all men' (5:18a)

**APP:** In Adam we have inherited sin, death, and condemnation **AND -Rom 5:12** – we all relive this sin through pride, self-love, and idolatry – we're outside garden, alienated from God, under covenant curse -need someone to get us back in

## D. God's covenant of Grace with Abraham

-but Adam's failure was not the end - **Gen 3:15** - proto-gospel -in **Gen 12:3** God calls Abram/Abraham and makes a covenant with him promising "in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed" -covenant not based on Abraham's obedience, but faith in God's promise

-Israel proves to be rebellious & idolatrous forfeit COV bc no FAITH -by end of **OT** looking for one faithful Israelite who can remove the curse of these broken covenants, *and fulfill the obedience required!* **ILLUST**: Start business to feed family – fails – start new to pay debts – fail at that too. Now need money to pay off debts, and money to eat!

#### II. Jesus succeeded where Adam & We failed.

-he is faithful to God's covenant

Rom 5:18-19: ...so one act of righteousness leads to justification and life for all men.... so by the one man's obedience the many will be made righteous.

-Jesus is righteous and obedient to his Father's plan

#### A. Jesus is the New Adam

- -God will bless the whole earth thru Jesus ONE faithful Israelite
- -Paul uses this language also in 1 Cor 15:22,
- -but Gospel writers also show Jesus is the **New Adam**

Hints in Matthew & Mark - but Luke Especially

Luke 3:38 - inserts genealogy between baptism & tempt. "Adam"

-point of temptations Jesus kept obeying God the rest of his life, even to death on a cross (Luke 4:18)

-Heb 2:17-18 – like us in every way but without sin

# B. Jesus tells us he came to establish the New Covenant with God 1 Cor 11:25, Luke 22:20

- -words of institution
- -New Covenant: forgiveness, regeneration, Spirit
- -take & eat vs took & ate

### III. Jesus secured all that Adam lost - and more.

## A. His obedient life and death deals with the covenant curse

- -one act of eating from the Tree is a sign of Adam's obedience/dis -so the cross becomes the "one act of righteousness"
- -kept the Law perfectly and he paid the penalty of the broken Law
- -through faith we joined to Christ and his covenant

# -2 Cor 5:21 - forgiveness AND righteousness

**ILL:** In covenant of marriage what is mine becomes ours.

### B. His death secures life and righteousness

**-Rom 5:18-19.** <sup>18</sup> Therefore, as one trespass led to condemnation for all men, so one act of righteousness leads to *justification and life for all men*. <sup>19</sup> For as by the [Adam's] disobedience the many were made sinners, so by the [Christ's] obedience *the many will be made righteous*.

## 1. In Covenant w/ Christ - justification/righteousness-

- -in COV with Adam we are condemned, under death
- -only by faith not works can we be transferred from the covenant of Adam to the Covenant of Christ.
- -not by our obedience but "by the obedience of Christ" many made right.
- -we stand in the right, we are counted keepers (not breakers) of COV

**ILLUS:** Aced the test, blew the curve, but gave us his grade. **APP:** obedience from security vs. obedience as performance

### 2. In Covenant w/ Christ life

- -Adam forfeited eternal life w/ God when he rebelled, & brought death
- -he lost the garden and took everyone else with him
- -Christ chose death in order that he might give us life with God in the Garden-City, the New Jerusalem in the New Creation.

**Rom 5:16** – "free gift" – all you can do is receive, but you must receive **ILL:** Leon Morris story of little boy at Church festival

**APP:** As we face the trials & temptations of life, and seek to obey God we must remember—Jesus already passed the test, he conquered sin, his righteousness is counted as mine by faith – and following him leads to eternal life.

Jesus succeeded where Adam & WE! failed. Amen.
