SCRIPTURE: EXODUS 18:13 – 20:17

COUNSEL (EXODUS 18:13-27)

The last time we see JETHRO is in this narrative after which we are told that he “went his way into his own land”. Scholars debate whether Jethro’s advice is GODLY or WORLDLY. What we can take away from this is that even Moses, who was a very great leader, sought and accepted wise COUNSEL, and so should we.

CONSECRATION (EXODUS 19:10-17)

Very specific instructions are given to Moses to relay to the people on how to prepare to meet GOD. Consecration is the devotion to or setting apart of anything to the SERVICE and WORSHIP of God. This consecration by Israel was God’s way of showing them that they were not to live like they did in their prior life in Egypt – they are to set themselves apart from this world and be dedicated to the God who had called them out of bondage to be His people. As Christians, we are to consecrate ourselves to JESUS who has called us out of

darkness into His marvelous light! We are to be His representatives to the world by thinking, speaking, and acting DIFFERENT from the world. Christians are called to consecration.

COMMANDMENTS (EXODUS 20:1-17)

Referred to as the Decalogue. “Deca” – meaning “ten” and “logue” – meaning “words”. These “Ten Words” are the HUB of all of Israel’s religious and civil laws, the first four pertain to their relationship with God and the last six pertain to their relationship with each other. They are a summary of divine rules for human conduct. Rules for (1) religion, (2) worship, (3) reverence, (4) time, (5) authority, (6) life, (7) purity, (8) property, (9) tongue, and (10) contentment. Nine out of ten are repeated in the NEW TESTAMENT. Though believers today are not under the Law (Rom. 6:15), they are under OBLIGATION to abide by the holy standards represented in the Ten Commandments. They are guidelines for our CONSECRATION to God.

CONCLUSION

Living this way will set us apart and cause others to ask: Why? To which we are now able to direct them to the God of Truth!
